## Did you know?

If a 1.0 FTE NMHS teacher has more than 155 students at ANY point on September 3, 2021 or after, the teacher is to receive an additional \$60 per student over 155 (up to 170), for each month that he/she has more than 155. This overage should begin being reflected on your September pay warrant. **\*\*For PE and Performance courses, this is true in excess of 225 students. \*\*TAs do not count as part of your 155 student contacts.
